
About AIIMS



Steps 2 Walk

Steps2Walk was developed and chartered as a non profit (501)(c)(3) corporation by Dr. Mark Myerson in 2000. He was responding to the ongoing need for education and training of international foot and ankle surgeons who had little access to ongoing and advanced training in the specialty. Simultaneously, although Dr. Myerson and his colleagues participated in various humanitarian programs abroad by performing surgery and teaching, Dr. Myerson recognized that this model was not sustainable since at best, they could treat only 25 patients per program visit. However, by training hundreds of surgeons they could ultimately help many thousand.

Every year Steps2Walk conducts dozens of programs around the world to help disabled patients regain their mobility and improve their quality of life.

Recruiting the leading specialists in the field of orthopedic foot and ankle surgery to volunteer their time and talent, they are able to conduct the utmost difficult surgeries and educate the next generation of local in-country surgeons on how to perform future surgeries by themselves.

The need for both the care of children and adults with disabling foot and ankle deformities as well as the education of orthopedic surgeons worldwide is clear. Goal is to continue with surgery, teaching, and education, but to focus this in countries where they perceived the need to be greatest.

The team includes 6 surgeons, two of whom are regional orthopedic leaders. During the visits, all the volunteer surgeons are responsible not only for patient care but also for the education of 50 orthopedic surgeons who attend the intense one-week program in order to maximize the potential for the future care of patients with similar deformities in their region.


